Interview with the President

Focus on Felician recently sat with Dr. Anne Prisco to get her thoughts about becoming the College's new president.

Q You've been at the President's desk since July 1. What have the first few months been like?

It's definitely been exciting. Felician is a vibrant place with many wonderful, smart, hardworking people, so it's been a pleasure. And it's also been quite busy. I'm trying my best to get to as many events as possible and meet on a regular basis with staff and administration, as well as meet with folks in the local communities. In that respect, it's been almost non-stop.

Q You've served in a variety of roles at several institutions of higher education. What attracted you to Felician College?

I have a great respect for the College's mission and the importance it plays in distinguishing our students as we endeavor to develop informed minds and understanding hearts. I also embrace the commitment to providing an education that develops competence, character and compassion, qualities integral to the fabric of society. All this, and in the state Bruce Springsteen calls home. I knew Felician would be a good fit for me.

Q What is your vision for Felician?

That's the question I've been asked most often. It's a challenging question to answer as a new president. I am looking at things with a fresh eye, new energy and high hopes. And I'm looking forward to working with our community as we consider Felician College's role in the higher ed landscape to broaden our academic programs, and with administration so Felician contin-

ues to provide our students with the best possible experience. Some themes, or areas of focus, center on innovation, internationalization and sustainability. But I'm not in this alone. So, during my first year, I will be on a listening tour—to engage with staff, faculty and students about thoughts, ideas and hopes for Felician.

Q What have been some of the challenges so far?

Well, I certainly didn't expect to have to deal with a hurricane. We convened an emergency management team in advance of the storm and everyone got the job done, making sure resident students and personnel were safe and secure. We sustained some damage on the campuses but compared to the devastation throughout the rest of the state, we were fortunate. I am very proud of those who stepped up to insure our students were safe and secure.

Also, like so many other schools in the Northeast, we are facing enrollment challenges. We're taking steps to meet those challenges, including adding new outreach programs, and increasing our online offerings.

Q What are your thoughts about the worth of a college education?

It's no secret that a college education will help you not only financially, but also in every aspect of your life – your health, friendships, community involvement. As a first-generation college graduate, I am passionate about the transformative power of education. That said, our country's economic and employment situation is a major concern for all of us. As a college, it's our duty to ensure that we offer programs that give students a leg-up, an edge. We are obligated to take a more global look and craft those programs to meet an ever-changing world.

Q What do you see as your responsibility as the first lay president of Felician College?

The Felician Sisters founded the College 70 years ago and infused an institution of higher learning with Franciscan values of compassion, respect, diversity, service, and peace and joy! I feel both humbled and honored that they have entrusted me with furthering this mission. I also feel that it is my duty to serve Felician by personal example for the sake of our students.

Q You're originally from Brooklyn, but spent the last six years in Los Angeles. How does it feel to be back on the East Coast?

I'm enjoying it a great deal. I really liked California—it's beautiful—but definitely not at all like the New York/New Jersey area. I will say, though, that being someplace so unlike what you're used to is "a gift" because it gives you a chance to see and experience life in a very different way. In that respect, you learn a lot about yourself and what you're really capable of achieving. I am happy to be back, though.

Q What's the best piece of advice you've received since arriving at Felician?

To keep an eye on the big picture because the future is important, but try to take one day at a time.

Q Have you made any interesting discoveries about the area since moving back?

Growing up in New York, we had neighborhoods that had their own personalities. But they were all part of one big city. What I find wonderful about North Jersey is that every town is its own unique entity. There are different cultures and groups of people that identify each town. You can go one place for something and drive just a few miles in either direction and experience a totally different atmosphere. And no one comments about my accent like when I was in LA!

Picture Perfect

F-Stop: Photography's Study Abroad Program lands in Florence, Italy

A trip to London convinced Mike Nyklewicz of the impact that travel can have on a student's education.

"I realized that the different cultures, the exposure to a different way of life can really add to the whole educational experience," said Professor Nyklewicz, current Chair of Art and Music at Felician, and one of the driving forces behind Felician College's Study Abroad Program.

Currently, the Summer Study Abroad Program starts with students meeting once weekly in the spring on the Felician campus and culminates the semester with a four-week long stay in Florence, Italy.

"If you're studying art, Florence is a perfect location," said Professor Nyklewicz, adding that one of the Spring 2013 courses will focus on Photography. The other is Travel Writing, taught by Dr. Kristen Abbey of the English Department.

Once there, Florence "becomes the classroom," he said, noting that course work includes excursions to the many museums, art galleries and cathedrals, as well as open-air markets, restaurants and other points of interest. Students also are encouraged to get a taste of the local flavor.

Housing is pre-arranged so that the students can live among the local residents.



"Study Abroad is a real eye opener... a mind opener," said Carlo Colechio, Director of Study Abroad. "Students who study abroad tend to be more academically sophisticated, and are creative thinkers who are more likely to see the interdependence that we all share as global citizens. Moreover, they come back with a greater sense of their place in the world and they are better equipped to work with individuals who are different from themselves."

Professor Nyklewicz added: "And what better way to learn about another culture? The kids are totally immersed in the Italian way of life. They're looking through a lens as well as with all their senses."

Faculty Learn the Finer Points of Online Teaching

Students who enroll in online courses at Felician College are assured a top-notch learning experience.

That's because every faculty member who signs on to teach online must first undergo extensive training and become certified as an e-instructor.

"Essentially, the teachers become online students in the certification process in order to experience e-learning from the inside out," said Dr. Dolores Henchy, Professor & Dean, Center for Assessment, Instructional Technology & Faculty Excellence.

Dr. Henchy admitted she was not always a believer.

"In the 1990s, online learning was limited to something called Professor in a Box, which at that time was nothing more than a glorified correspondence course," she said. "I thought, there's no way this kind of teaching can replicate a quality classroom experience."

Her participation in a series of online courses leading to certification as a Master Online Teacher, facilitated by the University of Illinois, convinced Dr. Henchy that this was indeed the path of learning for the future.

"I was sold. But I also realized that online teaching, just like in-classroom teaching, is only effective if it's done well," she said. "That means online instructors need to fully commit the time needed to know their

online students and actively engage students in a cyber format."

Dr. Henchy has developed instructional sessions for full-time and adjunct faculty that include several components: the basics of online teaching, course design, and practical implementation.

"Faculty have to learn new teaching methodologies, design and teach an online or hybrid course and participate in a review process to assure quality online instruction," she said. "It's an ideal process for assessing an e-facilitator's effectiveness."

Training sessions for full-time faculty are six weeks, held in late spring and early fall. A four-week session is offered to adjuncts, who work with a course that's designed by a full-time faculty member.

"In addition to the work itself, I evaluate the facilitator's engagement with students in a virtual office and virtual lounge, quality of student assessment feedback, and use of e-teaching/learning tools, all the factors that are part of the Franciscan commitment to caring for our students," said Dr. Henchy. "Just because they're not in a classroom, doesn't mean those things aren't necessary to the learning experience."

At present, about 40 percent of Felician's full-time faculty and approximately 15 percent of adjuncts are e-certified.

"What's interesting is that most instructors are finding that teaching an online course has also made them more effective in the on-ground classroom," Dr. Henchy said. "I think there's a deeper appreciation of how they can make a difference to their students."

Felician Partners with Area Schools for Teacher Development

Recognizing that teaching is an ever-evolving profession, Felician College is committed to developing partnerships with local elementary schools to help teachers in their professional development.

Faculty members of the College's Division of Education are providing daylong workshops with teachers in a variety of subject areas, including English Language Arts and Mathematics instruction and using iPads in the classroom. Felician's faculty also present the latest research and teaching techniques on the Common Core Standards set by the State.

"The Felician College Division of Education is committed to serving the educational community, and our partnerships with area schools are a good vehicle for that service," said Dr. Rose Rudnitski, Dean and Professor, School of Education.

Recently, Felician's faculty provided an in-service workshop at St. Andrew the Apostle School in Clifton and Academy of the Most Blessed Sacrament and St. Paul's School, both in Ramsey. Felician also has a similar relationship with a school in Managua, Nicaragua, where three

faculty and Dr. Rudnitski provided two days of professional development this past summer on assessing student learning.

"Our students are also involved in the schools, providing after-school tutoring at several area elementary schools," Dr. Rudnitski added.

"The goal of these partnerships is to establish relationships that go beyond presentations. Our Division of Education seeks to become involved in the activities of local schools through participation of our students and faculty in school improvement projects and in helping teachers solve problems that they encounter in the classroom," she said. "We want to be part of the solution."

Dr. Rudnitski explained that in many programs, teacher candidates do not go into real classrooms until the semester before they student teach.

"They often feel unprepared when faced with a real classroom situation. In our program, they are in real classrooms all day once a week from freshman year through their senior year," said Dr. Rudnitski, noting that teacher candidates will have been in a variety of placements -- urban, suburban, special education, Catholic, and Charter schools -- by the time they are eligible to student-teach.

"This is the gold standard in teacher preparation," she said.



First Class: The Doctor of Nursing

Felician College proudly welcomed this fall the first cohort of dedicated nurse professionals into the Doctor of Nursing Practice program, Felician's first doctoral program.

For almost fifty years Felician College has been providing outstanding nursing education, culminating now in the introduction of the DNP. According to Dr. Muriel Shore, Dean of the Division of Nursing and Health Management, the program will extend the College's efforts to educate "nurses who will design, lead and champion improvements in the nation's quality of health care."

Felician President Dr. Anne Prisco marked the significance of this institutional milestone, saying, "I commend Dr. Shore and her distinguished faculty, who have designed a doctoral program at the forefront of industry and educational standards and practices."

The students who will receive Felician College's first doctoral degrees bring experience primarily in medically underserved areas. They cur-

rently hold senior leadership positions in health care, including roles as Advanced Practice Nurses and Chief Nursing Officers according to Dr. Shore, who notes that they "understand the future challenges of nursing practice and come with a passion and goal for excellence in patient care."

The Doctor of Nursing Practice program, which students complete in approximately seven semesters and complete tracks in Advanced Practice or Executive Leadership, consists of online coursework, on-campus residencies, and a change initiative capstone project designed to integrate scholarship and practice.

Felician College is Military Friendly

For the second consecutive year, Felician College has been named by G.I. Jobs magazine as a Military Friendly School for its commitment to providing a support environment for armed forces veterans and their families.

Felician's inclusion on the list, which is the result of a survey of more than 12,000 schools, ranks it in the top 15 percent of all colleges, universities and trade schools nationwide.

As a military friendly institution, Felician offers dedicated financial benefits and has created uniquely tailored programs to help veterans and their families achieve their academic goals.

Seirra McCants, a four-year United States Navy veteran, is a Felician College student majoring in criminal justice with a minor in business. She serves as a student liaison between the College's admissions and financial aid offices and incoming students who also have military experience.

"I'm a mother, a wife and a full-time student so I have a hectic schedule, said Ms. McCants, of Union, New Jersey, who served her tour of duty in Japan. "But I am thrilled to be able to help other students with questions or concerns they might have, especially because I have a true understanding of what they've been through or what they are going through now."

Bachelor degree programs that qualify for military grants include Business, Computer Information Systems (CIS), Criminal Justice, Professional Studies, Healthcare Administration, Education and English. CIS and Criminal Justice are also offered as fully online options, and fast-track programs feature evening classes in eight-week sessions that allow students to further their educations while working during the day.

"I'm very proud of our commitment to the military program," said Dr. Anne Prisco, President of Felician College. "This is a wonderful way for us to show our deep appreciation for the men and women who have bravely served our country."

Felician College Grads Top Earners

Graduates of Felician College, the Franciscan College of New Jersey, get better-paying jobs than those who hold a diploma from Harvard University, according to a report by ABC News published earlier this fall.

The report included the latest data released by PayScale, which tracks college graduates' employment statistics and other higher education information.

Felician College ranks ninth, with a median starting salary of \$58,700. The latest crop of Harvard grads will earn \$54,100, according to the research.

"The mission of Felician College is to develop competence, character, and compassion within a liberal arts education," said Dr. Anne Prisco, President of Felician College. "Evidently, based on this recent study of earnings, what we believe and what we are instilling in our students is valued by employers in New Jersey and beyond."

A bonus for Felician grads: its tuition and fees are \$29,400, considerably less than Harvard's \$40,866. Cost figures are according to U.S. News' annual college ranking, which listed Felician as one of the top Best Northern Colleges in 2011.

Among the schools surveyed were private for-profit and non-profit, liberal arts, state, and engineering and technical schools.

Elaine Schomp Soroka, Class of '76

A chance meeting in 1989 led to a career that Elaine Soroka is convinced was meant for her.

After working as a nurse in a hospital cancer unit and emergency room, Elaine chose to stay home to raise her children. She stayed active, however, volunteering her time as a nurse at a local Catholic school and with the Red Cross.

When she was ready to return to the work force, a friend introduced her to Geraldine Delaney, who founded in 1957 the Alina Lodge, a long-term drug and alcohol rehabilitation facility in Blairstown, N.J.

"I wasn't even looking for a job there so I was surprised when she called and said I had the job," Elaine related. "I told her I would have to think about it. Instead, she told me, 'You're starting on Tuesday.'"

Elaine, who started as a part-time staff nurse at Alina, is now the Director of Nursing.

She supervises a team of 15 nurses, who work in tandem with medical doctors and psychologists.

"Alina is one of the oldest facilities of its kind in the country, so it has quite a distinguished reputation," Elaine said. The facility establishes long-term rehabilitation and recovery programs for men and women fighting addiction to drugs, alcohol, gambling, sex and eating disorders. Upon program completion, students, as they are called, go to a halfway home.

"We call them students because they are learning every day how to get healthy again and how to stay healthy," Elaine said, adding that Alina is affiliated with treatment centers in six other states. "We've had a good success rate but the reality is, facilities like ours will always be needed."

When asked if this was part of her career plan, Elaine said, "I wouldn't want to be anywhere else. What we're doing there is so important."





I also learned a lot about Saint Clare, a powerful woman, especially in that time, who merged strength and tenderness as a leader to create the Order [of Poor Ladies for women in the Franciscan tradition]. I definitely experienced moments of soul unfolding, being present rather than just reacting.

I am humbled that Felician does this for members of the College community. I was so moved that I wrote a poem about my time in Assisi, a quiet fortress carved in the side of the mountain. FOCUS ON: ROB ALBANO

‘Work ethic beyond belief’ key to success

Rob Albano had enjoyed a solid cross-country career at Felician College prior to this, his senior season. Albano had won five invitational races, set multiple school records, and in 2011 was named the Central Atlantic Collegiate Conference Runner of the Year and to the NCAA Division II All-East Region team, as well as a Capital One Academic All-American.

But by his own high standards, he was not satisfied.

“The hardest part for me was always putting together a full season,” said Albano, an elementary education major from Pompton Plains. “Whether it was getting sick, getting hurt, or taking a wrong turn on a course, something always seemed to happen that kept me from reaching my full potential.”

In 2012, however, the stars aligned for Albano. He won all four regular-season races he entered, including his fourth consecutive victory at the Philly Metro Small-College Invitational, and a win at the Lehigh University Paul Short Run White Race which contained 322 runners.

Albano went on to repeat as the CACC Runner of the Year, the first male ever to do so, and earn his second All-Region honor, the first Felician athlete in any sport to accomplish that feat in six years. And none of the results surprised him.

“The season met exactly what I wanted to accomplish,” Albano said. “Winning every meet but regionals was a goal of mine. Paul Short was a big accomplishment for me -- two years ago I was leading it and took a wrong turn. As you get faster, it becomes more and more difficult to take off time, but I’m 25 seconds faster than my freshman year.”

Running began for Albano as an alternative to team sports. He was inspired by an older brother Lou, who won a high school sectional title.

“Growing up I tried lots of sports -- our parents threw us in everything,” he said. “My brothers were somewhat good at team sports. I was uncoordinated. After I saw Lou’s success in running, I joined a club in fifth grade. In my first race, everyone beat me except for a couple of girls.”

But Albano soon discovered that in running, his self-admitted lack of natural athletic ability was less important to his success than his willingness to work hard. Felician 11th-year head coach John Brennan has worked with few runners who were willing to put in the effort that Albano was in order to be successful.

“Rob has a work ethic that is beyond belief,” Brennan said. “He’ll crank out 100-mile weeks, even in the hot summer months. There have been no shortcuts to his success. In a sport that’s more training than skill, Rob is the embodiment of what you can become if you are willing to sacrifice and train.”

According to Albano, the work ethic was born of finding an activity in which he could excel.

“In high school, I became running-obsessed,” he said. “I loved the individuality of the sport, the feeling of being fit, knowing that I’m good at something which also keeps me healthy. I found that I got better as the distance increased, so the transition to college was just about having that aerobic background and putting in those miles.”

Two major factors led Albano to Felician. The first was the presence in Rutherford of Pequannock Township High teammate James Vander Wiele, who won the CACC Runner of the Year award as a freshman while Albano was in his college-selection process. Albano also liked the idea that the Golden Falcons did not field a varsity track team.

“James was obviously pushing me to come to Felician,” Albano said. “Having a friend and such a good teammate like James a year ahead of me gave me something to shoot for. I also like the idea of living on campus but being able to go home whenever I want. I also find it difficult to peak three times in a season, so a school with just cross-country was just right for me. In cross-country, there’s one race, and one champion, and I feel like I can take anyone on at my specialty distance.”

While most college athletes must face the end of their playing careers after college, Albano is looking forward to the future.

“I love this sport too much to leave it,” he said. “I want to train to run half-marathons and marathons, with a goal of a 2 hour, 20 minute marathon. I also want to coach. I like dealing with high-mileage people, so maybe college coaching would be best for me.”

MEN'S SOCCER

The 2012 Felician men's soccer team missed the Central Atlantic Collegiate Conference playoffs by one point, finishing ninth in the conference with a record of 4-5-2 (14 points).

The Golden Falcons were 5-10-2 overall. The team suffered from an inconsistent offense, only once recording more than one goal in a game. All five of their victories were by 1-0 scores.

Sophomore defender Keleenna Onyeaka led the team in scoring from the center back position with four goals. Junior midfielder Azedine Maazouzi tied for seventh place in the CACC with five assists.

Onyeaka and senior midfielder Josh Delva were selected to the All-CACC Second Team. Onyeaka was also chosen for the Capital One Academic All-District squad.

WOMEN'S SOCCER

The women's soccer team qualified for the CACC Tournament for the fifth consecutive year under Coach Thomas Notte. The Golden Falcons recorded dramatic victories in their final two regular-season games to qualify for the playoffs. On Oct. 20, Felician trailed Georgian Court University, 2-0, at home with 25 minutes remaining before rallying for a 3-2 win. Three days later, junior Alysia Arcona broke a 2-2 tie with a goal in the 73rd minute for another 3-2 triumph.

The season ended in the CACC quarterfinals on Oct. 28, when top seed Wilmington University scored with fewer than six minutes remaining to hand Felician a 2-1 loss. The final won-lost-tied record was 7-9-1.

Arcona scored 12 goals for the season, tying for third place in the CACC. She was recognized as a

second-team All-CACC honoree. Freshman Macki Groves scored six goals, and senior Emily Gleason led the team with six assists.



WOMEN'S VOLLEYBALL

Felician struggled to an overall won-lost record of 1-24. The victory came in dramatic fashion, in five sets at home against Goldey-Beacom College on Sept. 22, by a score of 15-13 in the fifth set.

Senior Jenna Matesic became Felician's career leader in kills, finishing with 891 for her career. Freshman Kayla Gallagher set a single-season school record with an attack percentage of .208.

The Golden Falcons raised more than \$1,600 for breast cancer research at its "Dig Pink" event on Oct. 19 against Bloomfield College.

MEN'S CROSS-COUNTRY

Senior Rob Albano enjoyed the greatest single season on record at Felician. Albano won all four of his regular-season races, captured the CACC Championship event on Oct. 21, and made the NCAA Division All-East Region team for the second time.

Albano is the first male in CACC history to win the conference Runner of the Year award more than once. He captured the honor in 2011 and 2012. He is also the first two-time all-region performer at Felician in any sport in seven years.

Senior Taylor Trumbetti was a more-than-capable No.2 runner. Trumbetti finished second to Albano in the CACC meet, and also made the all-region team.


WOMEN'S CROSS-COUNTRY
