

Estimated Cost of Attendance: Non-Traditional Undergraduate Programs (Full-Time)

2022-2023

The Felician University Cost of Attendance (COA) is an estimate of a student's educational expenses for a period of enrollment (costs below are based on the academic year). Federal law dictates the types of expenses that can be included in a cost of attendance. Regulations allow schools to set the allowances used for each type of cost and create a cost of attendance for different categories of students.
