

Estimated Cost of Attendance: Non-Traditional Graduate Program (Full-time) 2024-2025

The Felician University Cost of Attendance is an estimate of a student's educational expenses for a period of enrollment (costs below based on the academic year). Federal law dictates the types of expenses that can be included in the Cost of Attendance. Regulations allow schools to set the allowances used for each type of cost and create a Cost of Attendance for different categories of students.

Note: The maximum amount that can be borrowed from the Federal Direct (PLUS) Loans or an alternative (private) loan is the Felician University Estimated Cost of Attendance stated above minus other financial aid received.
