Estimated Cost of Attendance 2026-2027 Academic Year

This *Estimated* Cost of Attendance is specific to students who started the Hybrid ABSN program in Fall 2026. This document is to be used in conjunction with your Financial Aid Award Letter in planning your expenses for the 2026-2027 Academic Year.

As a Hybrid ABSN student for the Fall 2026 Cohort 22, your planned enrollment is predetermined and outlined below based on a tuition of \$895 per credit. This enrollment pattern outlines your direct costs of tuition and fees, which will be billed by the University. The difference between your Offer of Assistance (Award Letter) and the Estimated Cost of Attendance is the amount of aid you can receive from an Alternative Loan Source.
